### **MODEL T DICTIONARY** A few helpful terms:

RADIATOR - otherwise known as "Old Faithful" geyser. RADIUS ROD - one of half a hundred iron bars somewhere underneath. RATTLE - song of the Model T. **REAR WHEELS** - front wheels while reversing car. ROAD HOG - the other fellow on a narrow road. SELF STARTER - one who can start his own car without help. SHOCK ABSORBERS - passengers in the rear seat. SIDE CURTAINS — used to keep the outside weather inside. SPARE TIRE - round thing that is always without air. SPARK PLUGS - carbon collecting porcelain. THROTTLE LEVER - that cow is still passing us. TOP - one-man or two-man, better gather your friends for help. UPROAR - starting out. VULCANIZER - one who vulks.
